Police Make Arrests and Recover Firearms

Oakland, CA — BART and Oakland Police safely make arrest of two suspects in connection with a robbery and recover a firearm.

On October 4, 2012, at 11:50 P.M., a citizen reported to BART P. D. that they had been robbed at gun point by three suspects in the area of 7200 San Leandro Boulevard.

BART Police observed the suspects and pursued them into a nearby industrial storage yard in the 700 block of 71st Avenue. Oakland Police were requested to assist. A team of search officers was assembled. The search resulted in the safe arrest of two juvenile suspects. The third suspect is still at large. A firearm was recovered along with the victim's loss. BART Police arrested both juvenile suspects in connection with the robbery.

Oakland Police safely arrest two suspects and recover three loaded firearms.

October 8, 2012, at 1:00 AM, Oakland Police Officers responded to the area of 99th Ave and International Boulevard on a report of subjects in the area armed with firearms.

When the officers arrived on scene they observed three subjects, one subject fled on foot subsequently avoiding police detection. The other two subjects were safely detained. Officers recovered three loaded firearms. Officers arrested both subjects for firearms related offenses.
