Oakland, CA - Advisory: Update: 3300 Block of Chestnut Street - Officer Involved Shooting

Oakland police and investigators remain at the scene of an officer-involved shooting this afternoon. One suspect was struck by gunfire and was transported to a nearby hospital with reportedly non-life threatening injuries, and a second suspect remains in police custody at this time. No officers were reported to have been injured.

At 2:27pm, OPD Communications dispatchers received a 911 call regarding an in-progress burglary reported by a citizen within the 3300 block of Chestnut Street. The first OPD unit of several was dispatched at 2:28pm for a "priority 1" emergency response, and officers arrived on-scene at 2:29pm. Preliminary reports are that officers, as they prepared to tactically set a perimeter and respond, encountered a suspect armed with what appeared to be a firearm. One officer discharged a duty weapon at the suspect striking him in the shoulder. A second suspect was safely taken into custody.

The recovered firearm was determined to be a non-operational, replica firearm. A photo of the recovery is attached to this message.
