### **Oakland Police Make Arrests**

*Oakland, CA — One of our commitments this new year is to strengthen our communication within our community, and better share crime information, prevention, response and enforcement results.*

**On April 14, 2013**, at 10:20 AM, Oakland Police officers responded to the 300 block of 11th Street on a report of an auto burglary. Witnesses observed the suspect break into a parked car, remove the loss, and flee. The witnesses provided Dispatch with a detailed description of the male adult suspect, whom officers were later able to locate and arrest in connection with the burglary. The victim's loss was recovered.

**On April 15, 2013**, at 1:20 PM, Oakland Police responded to the 1300 block of Broadway on a report of a robbery. The victim, a 97-year-old female, had money snatched out of her hand by the suspect, who then fled the area. Two witnesses provided detailed descriptions of the robbery suspect. An ambassador from the Downtown Oakland Ambassadors Program immediately alerted OPD. Because of detailed descriptions provided by witness, the working partnership of the Downtown Ambassadors Program, and the quick response of the Oakland police, the female adult suspect was arrested in connection with this robbery and the victim's money was recovered.

**On April 15, 2013**, at 10:10 PM, Oakland Police officers responded to the area of 12th and Oak streets on a report of an armed robbery. The victim told police that he had been robbed at gunpoint by three male suspects. Due to the detailed description provided by the victim, responding officers were able to locate and arrest one male juvenile in connection with the robbery and recovered a gun. While officers were at the scene, a second victim notified officers that he had also been robbed by three suspects and provided a similar description. Officers were able to recover partial loss for both victims.

The above cases are pending review by the Alameda County District Attorney's Office. The investigations are ongoing and anyone with information is asked to contact investigators at (510) 238-3326 (robbery) or (510) 238-3951 (burglary), or Crime Stoppers of Oakland (510) 777-8572.
