OPD Requests Community Help to Solve Assault of 82-Year-Old Victim

Oakland, CA — The Oakland Police Department is requesting assistance from media and the community regarding any information that can help identify the responsible person(s) for an assault on an 82-year-old man. The assault occurred on December 24, 2013, in the area of 9th Avenue and East 28th Street between the hours of 11:00 PM and 11:35 PM.

Investigators have released this photo of Phuc Pham, who was the victim of the December 24, 2013 assault.

The victim is described as a male Asian, 82 years old, 5'6", 150 pounds, salt and pepper hair and clean shaven.

BACKGROUND: On December 24, 2013, between the hours of 11:00 PM and 11:35 PM, officers responded to Park Boulevard and East 28th Street on a report of an assault. The victim was later identified as Phuc Pham who is 82 years old and a resident in the area. Pham was transported

to a local hospital where he remains in the Intensive Care Unit and has suffered multiple facial fractures and broken ribs.
