The AACC, comprised of local for-profits and non-profit organizations, law enforcement agencies, corporations and community leaders, was organized in 1986. Four years later, in 1990, Officer Robert Sayaphupha and community leader Walter Chinn founded AYSC. Since its start, AYSC has developed and prepared middle and high school students for higher education and leadership positions within the Asian community. Members come from a variety of social and economic backgrounds, and many have been able to go on to college and higher institutions thanks to the support of the AACC.
