**Oakland, CA** – The Oakland Police Department is requesting assistance from the media and the community in helping to solve a 2014 homicide case. Criminal Investigations Division Lieutenant Roland Holmgren and Homicide Investigator Leo Sanchez will be discussing the case, which occurred on January 19, 2014, at 100<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Longfellow Avenue. Family members of the victims, identified as Lamar Broussard, 19, and Derryck Eugene Harris, 19, will also be present.

Investigators will also be discussing the homicide that occurred on December 31, 2013, the shooting of Broussard's brother, Lee Weathersby III, 13, in the 1400 block of 104th Avenue. Weathersby died January 1, 2014.
