**Police Need Help In Identifying and Locating A Homicide Suspect**

*Oakland, CA* — The Oakland Police Department requests assistance from the media and the Oakland community to help identify and locate a suspect whom they believe is responsible for the homicide of Jerry Ezell Harbin, 36, of Oakland.

On November 14, 2016, at 1:08 PM, Oakland police officers responded to the 1100 block of 32<sup>nd</sup> Street to investigate a reported shooting. Upon arrival, officers located victim Harbin suffering from a fatal gunshot wound(s).

Investigators have released these photos of the suspect and the suspect vehicle, taken just after the crime was committed.

**Suspect** – is described as an African American male, late 20's, 5'9 -6'0", slim build, black hair with a beard. In the photo the suspect is wearing a dark colored T-shirt, jeans and dark shoes. The suspect appears to be carrying an object, possibly a gun, in his right hand.

**Suspect Vehicle** – is described as a 2012 Chevy Malibu, white in color.

The Oakland Police Department and Crime Stoppers of Oakland are offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to an arrest in this case.
