The Oakland Police Department Arrests Homicide Suspect; District Attorney Charges

Oakland, CA – On September 14, 2017, at 11:13 a.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a fatal shooting in the 600 block of 42th Street. Responding officers located a man who had been shot. The victim, Jason Coleman, 44, of Oakland, was transported to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

Soon after the shooting, Oakland and Bay Area Rapid Transit police officers located the suspect, Curtis Standley, 28, and took him into custody. A firearm was recovered.

On September 18, 2017, the Alameda County District Attorney's Office charged Standley with the murder of Coleman.
