**Gang Member Sentenced to 33 Years in Prison
for Shooting Oakland Police Officer**


Oakland, CA – On September 20, 2017, the United States Federal Court sentenced Damien McDaniel, 27, of Oakland, for shooting and wounding an Oakland Police officer on January 21, 2013.

United States Attorney Brian Stretch said, “Today’s sentence assures the public that this violent criminal will be off the streets for the next three decades.” McDaniel was sentenced to 33 years in a federal prison.

Oakland, CA — At 6:22pm this evening, an Oakland Police Department undercover officer was working within the 1700 block of Seminary Avenue on follow-up reconnaissance regarding a recent shooting connected to the area. While in the area, the officer was accosted by three armed men; during the physical confrontation, and before nearby uniformed officers could respond, the officer suffered a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the arm. The officer was transported to a local hospital for treatment as officers established a perimeter around the scene.

One person has been detained in connection with this incident. Incident commanders have called additional personnel and resources to the scene to ensure a safe and thorough search occurs for all involved - community members and residents in the area, officers, and the suspects themselves.

Access to the scene remains restricted as this investigation and search continues. Please call 9-1-1 (or 510-777-3211 by cell) if you are in or near the 1700 block of Seminary and become aware of any potentially related and suspicious activity.

The above information was provided by Chief Howard Jordan and Public Information Officer Johnna Watson from the scene. A formal press release and statement will be issued tomorrow morning once additional circumstances become known or are verified.
