Suspect Arrested In Child Pornography Case

Oakland, CA – On November 7, 2017, the Oakland Police Department Vice and Child Exploitation Unit along with FBI agents, conducted an investigation that resulted in the service of a search warrant and arrest. The search warrant led to the recovery of more than 100,000 child pornography images from a computer belonging to Davey Wayen Hudson (3/11/1962) who was arrested at his Oakland home where the warrant was served.

On November 9, 2017, the Alameda County District Attorney's Office charged Hudson with multiple counts of possession and distribution of child pornography on his computer.

The Oakland Police Department and the Alameda County District Attorney's Office continue to work together to combat human trafficking and sexual exploitation of children. The Oakland Police Department is dedicated to prevention, enforcement, community education and partnerships when it comes to cases such as these.
