




## THOMAS W. PRINDIVILLE

July 6, 1941



Nearing the end of his shift, Motorcycle Patrolman Thomas W. Prindiville, age 33, began to ride his motorcycle home. He traveled eastbound on 14th Street.

As he approached the Alameda County Courthouse he lost control of the bike and struck the side of an oncoming vehicle. Officer Prindiville remained on the motorcycle as it skidded into a nearby signal control box.

The resulting collision caused massive injuries, and Officer Prindiville died at the scene.
