



TIMOTHY DUANE

April 18, 1930



On April 9, 1930, Officer Timothy Duane was hit by a car while directing traffic at 10th Avenue and East 14th Street (now International Boulevard). The impact threw him into the path of a second vehicle, which also struck him. He was transported to Highland Hospital with a fractured skull and remained there until succumbing to his injuries.

Officer Duane had served with the Oakland Police Department for 20 years. He was survived by his three children and one grandchild.

Duane, 58, died of his injuries April 18.
