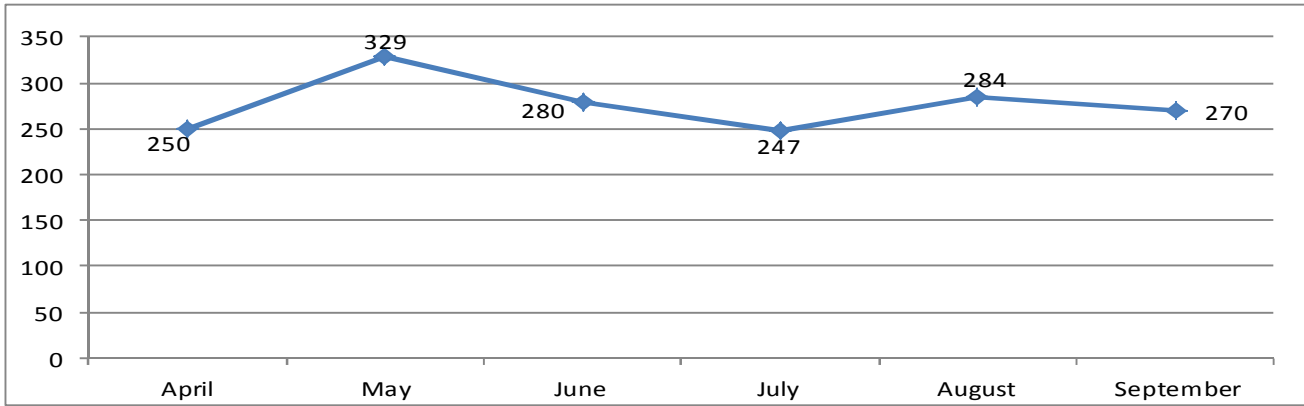

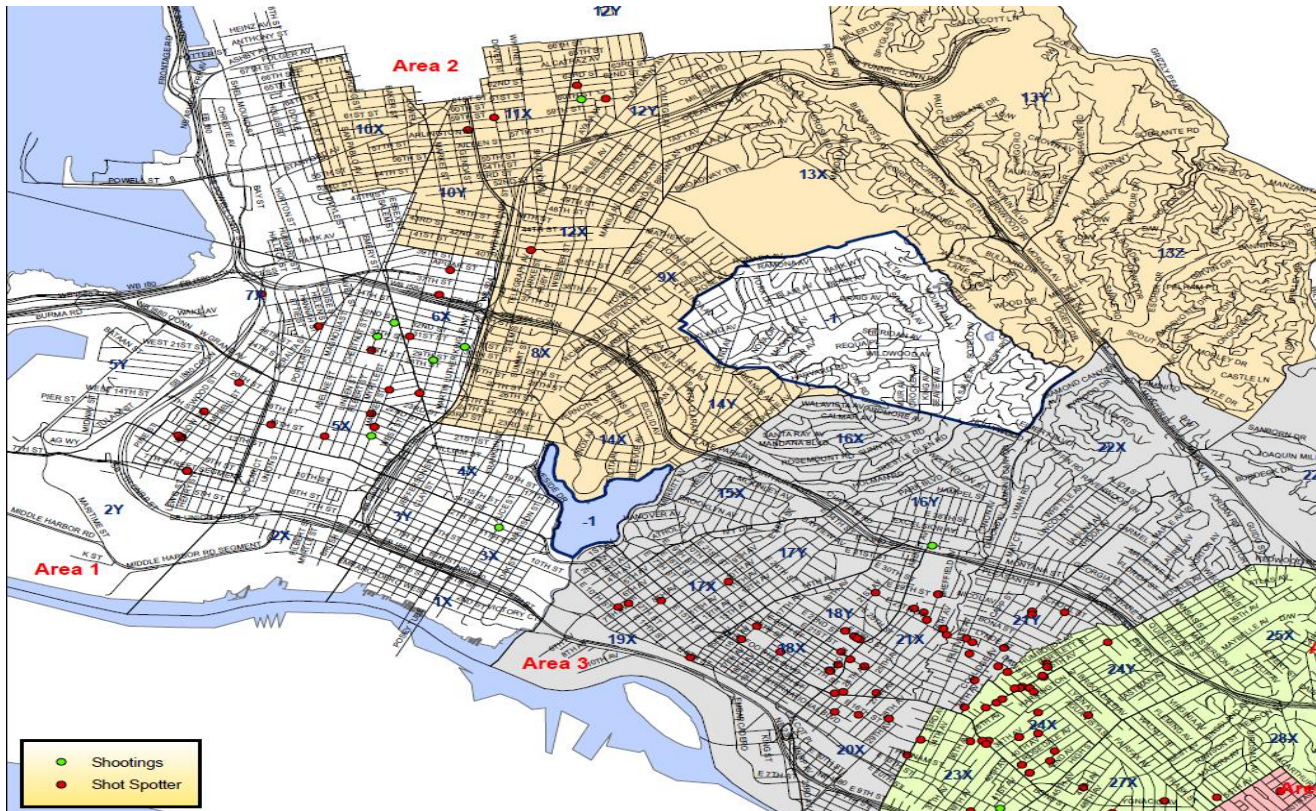


**WEST OAKLAND (Area's 1-3) SHOT SPOTTER INCIDENTS**

**Area 3: 41 Incidents**



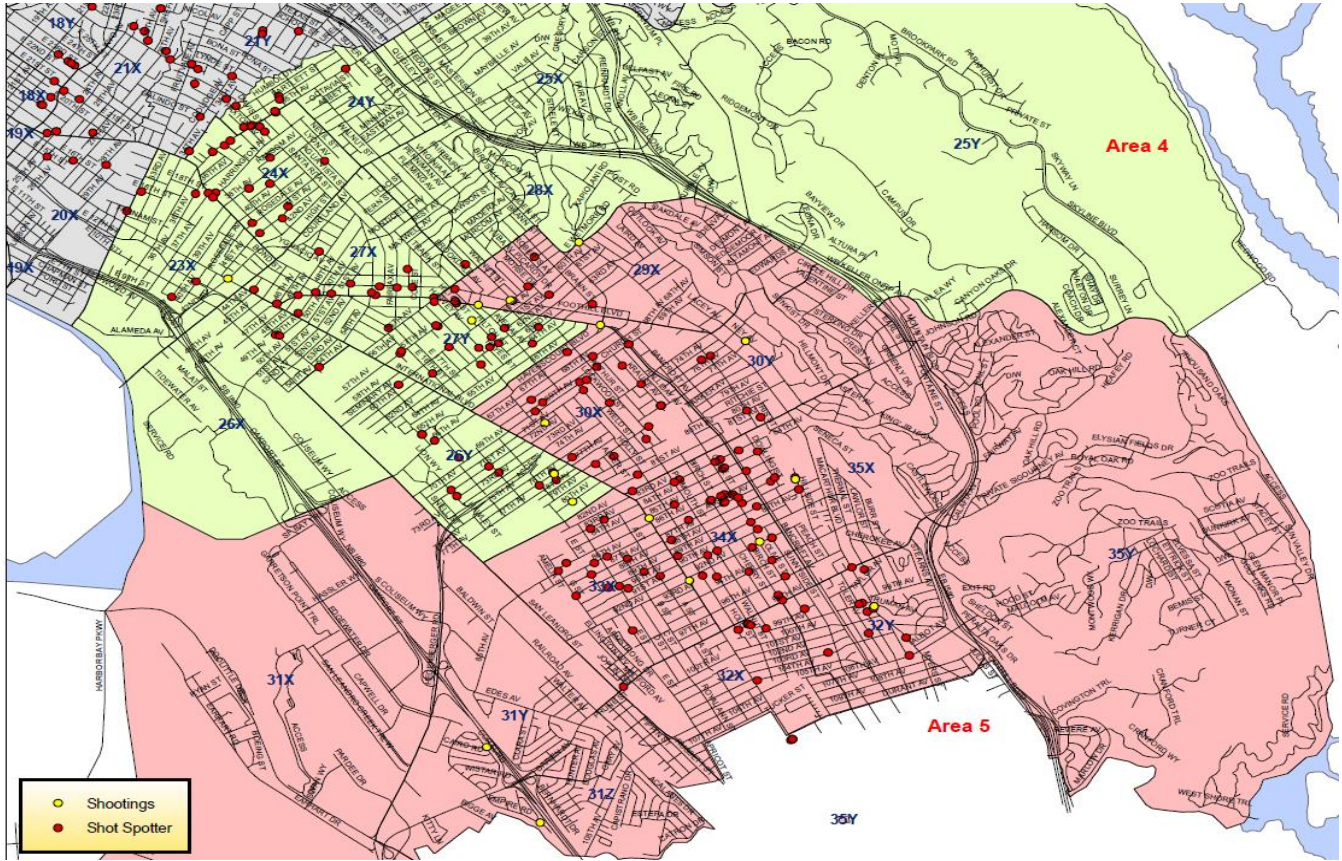
