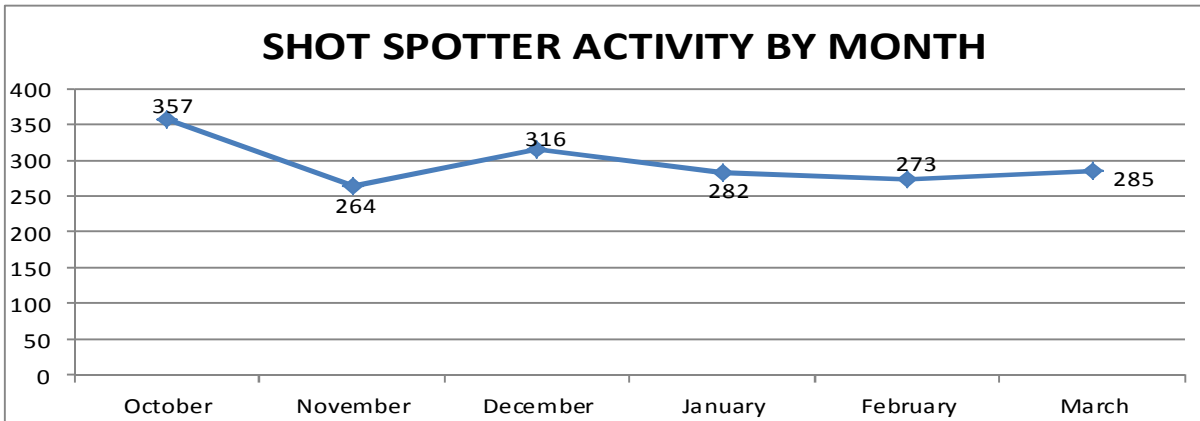

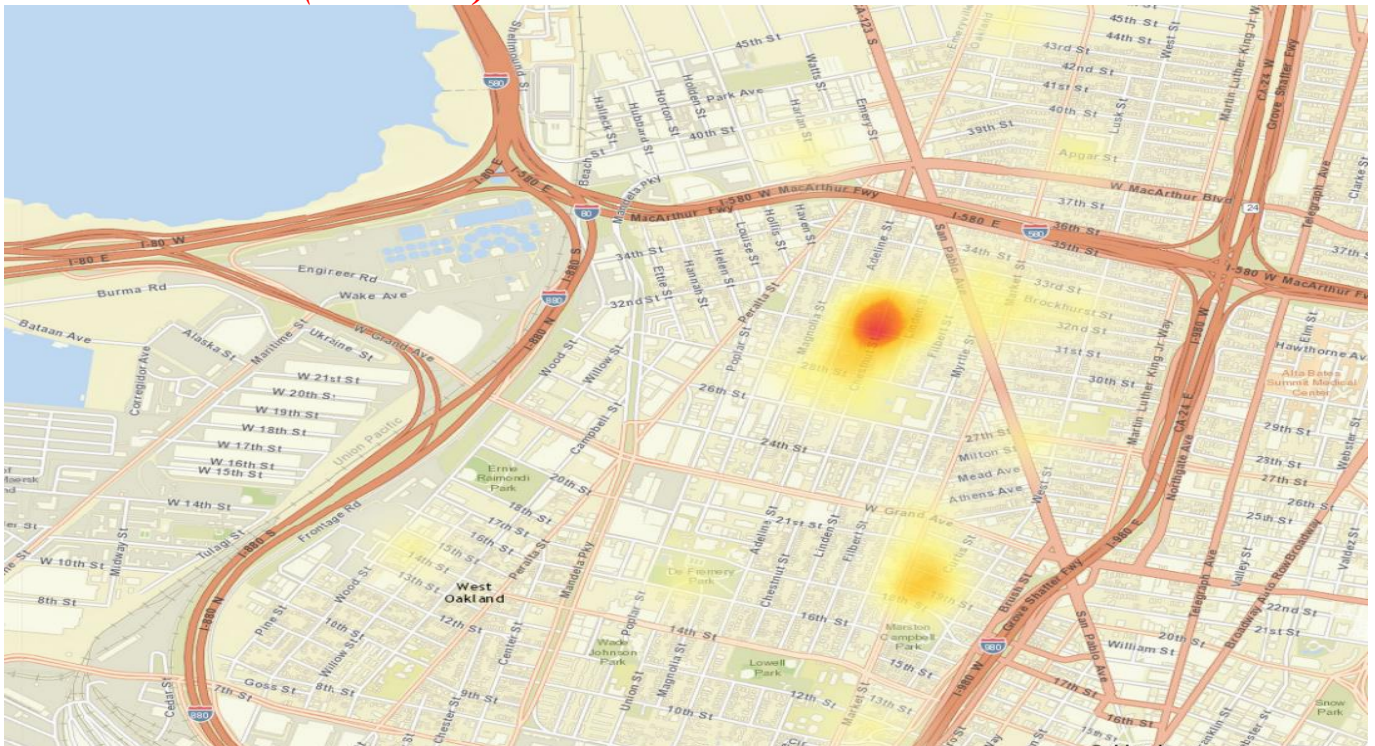

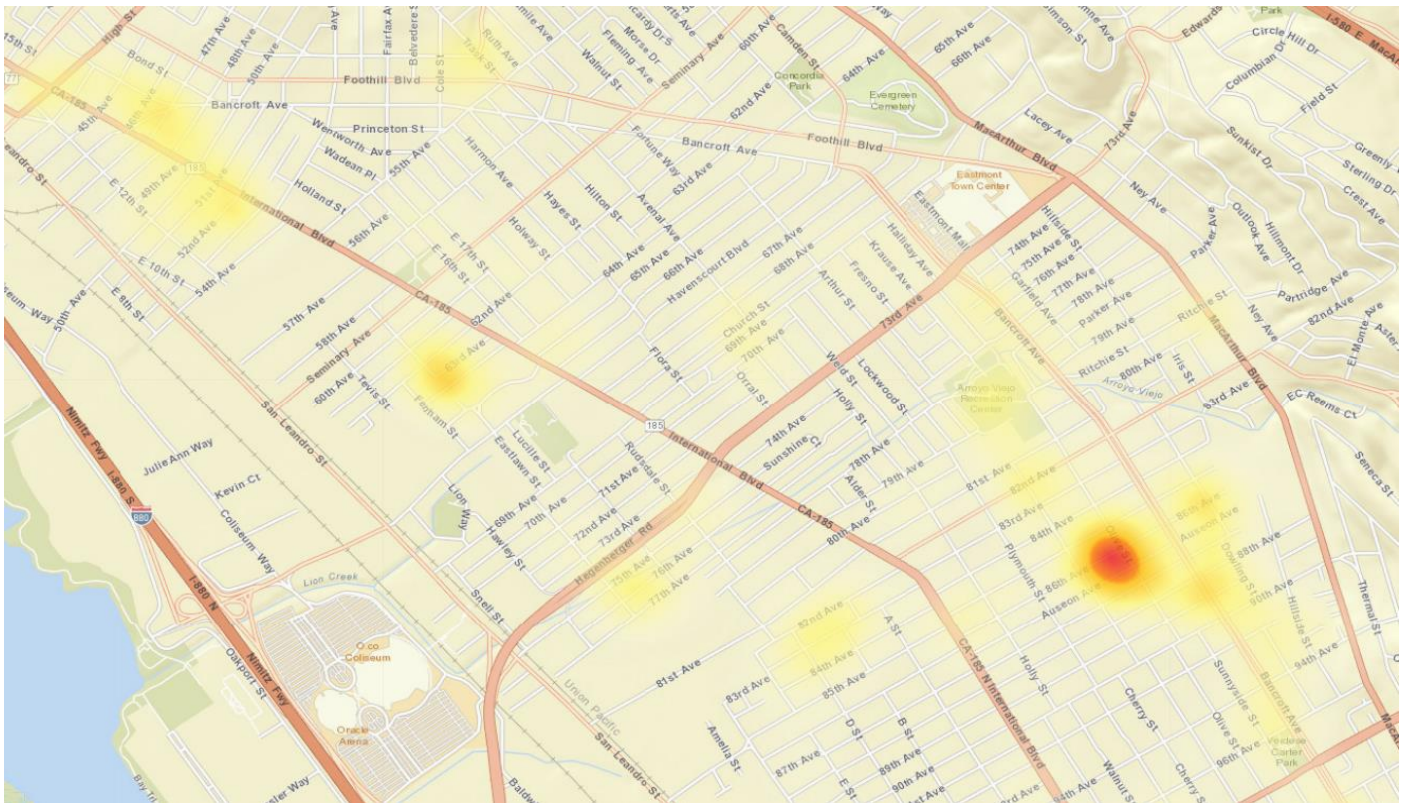
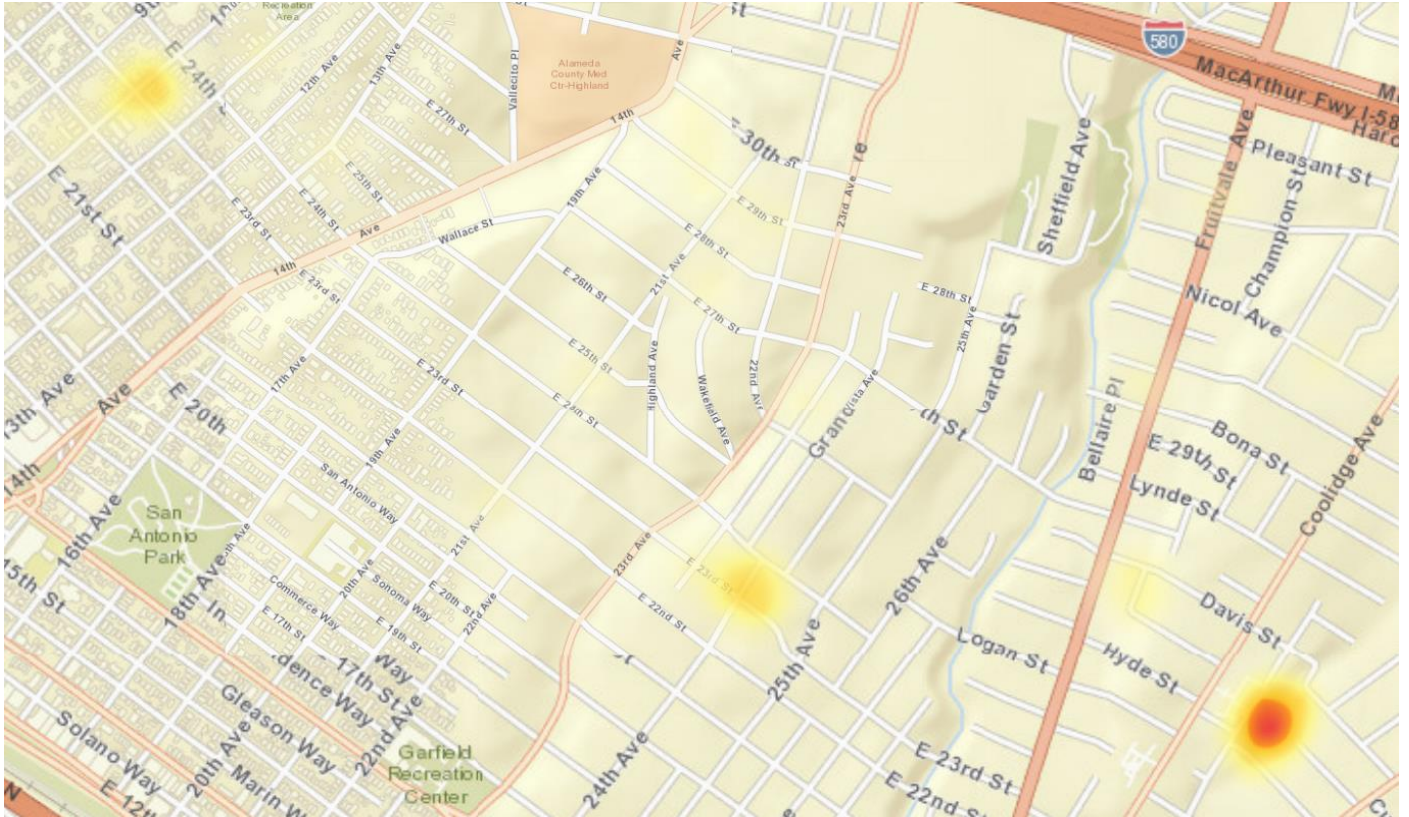


WEST OAKLAND (Area's 1-3) SHOT SPOTTER INCIDENTS
