How is Oakland changing the way it polices to restore community trust and better serve our residents?



Dr. PAUL FIGUEROA – Assistant Chief of Police, Oakland Police Department, began his career in law enforcement as an Oakland Police Cadet in 1991. He worked his way up the ranks at the Oakland Police Department and now serves as the Assistant Chief of Police. Paul has experience in field command, criminal investigations, and community policing programs. He has served as the commander in the Patrol Division, Training Section, Internal Affairs Division, Inspector General's Office, and as Chief of Staff to the Chief of Police.

Paul holds a doctoral degree and is a nationally recognized expert on procedural justice, police legitimacy, and police training techniques.



VENUS D. JOHNSON – Associate Attorney General for California Attorney General Kamala D. Harris is a senior policy advisor to the Attorney General – focusing particularly on criminal justice policy, law enforcement, criminal prosecutions. As an expert in criminal law and law enforcement, she represented the Attorney General's Office on a wide variety of matters before the California Legislature.

Venus was born and raised in Oakland and proudly served as a Deputy District Attorney for eight years in the Alameda County District Attorney's Office. She also serves as a Commissioner on the State Bar's Commission on Access to Justice.



ARNOLD PERKINS – Human Rights Advocate, retired as director of the Alameda County Public Health Department in Oakland, a position he held since 1994. His background includes such varied positions as high school teacher, counselor, and principal; nonprofit organization executive director; family counselor and advocate; foundation program officer; college teacher and administrator; and restaurant owner and operator.

Arnold is committed to public health, youth and criminal justice. He participated in President Obama's My Brother's Keeper Initiative in the Bay Area and beyond to improve life outcomes for boys and young men of color across the U.S.


