City leaders and members of the Oakland Police Department joined the community in celebrating the opening of a new community center resource on Thursday, September 22, 2016, as the High Street substation was unveiled.

Mayor Libby Schaaf, Oakland City Councilmember Noel Gallo, Assistant Chief of Police David Downing and Area 4 Acting Captain Nishant Joshi cut the ceremonial ribbon to open the center, located at 1452A High Street. The 650-square-foot substation was in the works for about one year as the property owner and the police department collaborated on bringing the project to fruition.

Acting Captain Joshi hopes to develop the center into a place where school-age children can do research papers, work on homework alongside officers writing reports or taking meal breaks. Oakland Athletics mascot Stomper served as the department's special surprise guest.


