

Carjacking / 5100 Block Shafter Avenue / In-Custody

On February 2, 2017, at approximately 4:37 p.m., Oakland police officers responded to the 5100 block of Shafter Avenue on a report of a carjacking. Responding officers made contact with the victim and received a description of the vehicle taken. Approximately 10 minutes later, officers located the vehicle occupied and traveling in the 4800 block of Telegraph Avenue. Officers attempted a traffic stop and the vehicle failed to comply, which then a vehicle pursuit ensued. The pursuit ended when the stolen vehicle crashed in the area of Broadway Terrace and the Highway 13 onramp. Two (2) suspects, an adult male and female, fled from the vehicle. Responding officers established a perimeter around the area of the 5800 block of Pinewood Road. Within the perimeter, officers made verbal contact with the suspects, gave the suspects commands to surrender, and both suspects were safely taken into custody without further incident.

At this time, no injuries were reported during this incident and two (2) additional vehicles were reported damaged during the vehicle pursuit.
