OPD ARRESTS DOUBLE HOMICIDE SUSPECT / D.A. CHARGES - On July 12, 2017, the Oakland Police Department arrested 37-year-old homicide suspect, Antonio Belvine. Belvine was arrested for the murders of Jose Gameros-Alvarado, 27, and Pedro Gonzalez, 32, that occurred in the 9500 block of Birch Street on June 11, 2017, at 5:44 p.m.

On July 14, 2017, the Alameda County District Attorney's Office charged Belvine with the murders of Gameros-Alvarado and Gonzalez.

**Police Seek Community Help in Unsolved Homicides**

**Oakland, CA** – The Oakland Police Department is requesting the public's assistance in solving the homicides of Lee Weathersby, Latrice Broussard and Derrick Harris.

On December 31, 2013, at 9:28 p.m., 33-year-old Lee Weathersby was murdered in the 1400 block of 20th Avenue. On January 29th, 2014, at 2:17 p.m., Derrick Harris and Latrice Broussard were murdered in the 1000 block of Longfellow Avenue. Weathersby and Broussard were together. The suspect vehicle is a silver Dodge Durango (shown below).



Investigators have provided a photo of the victims and are requesting help from anyone who may have seen them.

- Saw a silver Dodge Durango in the 1400 block of 20th Avenue on the evening of the shooting (December 31, 2013) from 9:00 p.m. to 9:28 p.m.
- Saw a silver Dodge Durango in the area of 1000 Avenue and Longfellow Avenue on the day of the shooting (January 29, 2014) from 2:17 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Witnessed the shooting.
- Saw a suspect driving the same after the shooting.
- Has any information on the suspect vehicle parked above (Silver Dodge Durango).

Oakland Police and Crime Stoppers of Oakland are offering a reward of up to \$20,000 for information leading to arrests in these cases.

OPD ARRESTS HOMICIDE SUSPECT; DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARGES – On June 4, 2017, at approximately 3:20 a.m., Oakland police officers responded to a report of a fatal shooting in the 1600 block of Linden Street. Responding officers located the victim, 32-year-old Andrew Williams of San Pablo, who was pronounced deceased on scene.

On June 8, 2017, the murder suspect, 31-year-old Artison Manalastas of Antioch, was located and taken into custody by the Oakland Police Department.

On June 12, 2017, the Alameda County District Attorney's Office charged Manalastas with the murder of Williams.

**City of Oakland Supports Findings of Federal Court-appointed Investigation into Police Officer Sexual Misconduct**

Oakland, CA — Federal Court-appointed investigator Edward Swanson released the findings of an extensive investigation into the City of Oakland's response to allegations of officer sexual misconduct last year. Mr. Swanson, a private attorney who was appointed by United States District Court Judge Thomas Swabson to review the adequacy of the Oakland Police Department's investigations into potential officer sexual misconduct, what can be learned from the initial investigation, how best to handle such cases, and whether City leadership responded adequately to the allegations.

"Can you be sexual misconduct-related related public trust in the Oakland Police Department," asked Oakland Mayor Elihu Richardson. "We are determined to ensure that public trust. It's a lot of things that we're looking at a culture that includes misconduct from officers, whether they are on or off duty. Hopefully, we will see evidence that leads to Oakland."

"We appreciate the report from Mr. Swanson and the court, and we are completely prepared to implement all of its recommendations. As an organization, the City is committed to consistent officer discipline and improvement. That will be our main goal."

"Along these lines I fully accept this report and appreciate its findings. It has diagnosed a problem, but as Mr. Swanson said, in his own words, it is all resolvable. The points to strong leadership, clear procedures, and a commitment on our part to care and treat all victims with care and attention. I commit to you that I can give the kind of leadership that you do not believe we have. My presence here is all about one thing."

Referring to the officers who engaged in misconduct, Chief Kirkpatrick added, "I reported 1,200 members of this department. You're people, 1,200 members of this department and I am a voice for them. They are not to be and disciplined in their fellow members, but we are not all about going forward. I personally apologize what law enforcement falls our citizens and victims. I come knowing about our past. I own it and I will move us forward."

"There, some people will see this as a setback. I don't see it as a setback. I see reports that this is a setback, a starting point for the future. We are ready to move forward. And I am proud to be your chief. I'm thank you, because for this report, we are committed to being the best of the best in law enforcement."
