OAKLAND POLICE ARREST HOMICIDE SUSPECTS / DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARGES - On September 11, 2017, at approximately 7:13 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a report of a man down in the area of Davenport Avenue and Calaveras Avenue. In the area, responding officers located Jesus Martinez, 38 of San Leandro, suffering from gunshot wounds. Martinez was pronounced deceased at the scene.

During the investigation, Oakland Police homicide investigators subsequently developed information, including video surveillance and witness statements that led to the arrests of Jose Alas and Chris Yen on October 26, 2017.

On Monday, October 30, 2017, the Alameda County District Attorney charged Alas, 37 of San Leandro and Yen, 36 of Oakland, with the murder of Martinez.

SUSPECT SENTENCED TO 33-YEARS IN PRISON FOR SHOOTING OAKLAND POLICE OFFICER – On September 20, 2017, the United States Federal Court sentenced Damien McDaniel, 27, of Oakland, for shooting and wounding an Oakland Police officer on January 21, 2013.

United States Attorney Brian Stretch said, “Today’s sentence assures the public that this violent criminal will be off the streets for the next three decades.” McDaniel was sentenced to 33-years in a federal prison.

OPD ARRESTS HOMICIDE SUSPECT; DA CHARGES - On September 14, 2017, at 11:13 a.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a fatal shooting in the 600 block of 42th Street. Responding officers located a man who had been shot. The victim, Jason Coleman, 44, of Oakland, was transported to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

Soon after the shooting, Oakland and Bay Area Rapid Transit police officers located the suspect, Curtis Standley, 28, and took him into custody. A firearm was recovered.

On September 18, 2017, the Alameda County District Attorney’s Office charged Standley with the murder of Coleman.
