



## OPD on the Beat Reports 2018

### *January 2018*

On Wednesday, January 31, the Oakland Police Department announced that a homicide suspect has been arrested. OPD partnered with other law enforcement agencies to locate and arrest the person responsible for a homicide that occurred at 2:46 am on December 17, 2017, in the 1600 block of 90th Avenue.

On Monday, January 29 at 5:23 pm, Oakland Police officers responded to the 1700 block of Embarcadero on a report of a man armed with a knife. When they arrived on scene, the officers instructed the man to drop the knife. Instead, he began to walk toward them, still armed with the knife. Using less-than-lethal force, the officers were able to take the individual into custody without injury.

On Sunday, January 28 at approximately 5:15 am, a takeover robbery of a business occurred in the 1900 block of International Boulevard. The victims were threatened with firearms and forced to turn over their property. Oakland Police officers responded to the scene and four male suspects were taken into custody.

On Tuesday, January 16 at about 2:00 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a strong arm robbery in the 8100 block of International Boulevard. The victim stated that the suspect had taken a tablet from her and driven away. At about 11:32 p.m. the same day, officers spotted the suspect vehicle and arrested the suspect in the area of High Street and San Leandro Street.

On Tuesday, January 16 at 7:11 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a shooting in the 2300 block of Market Avenue. After further investigation, officers located the suspect and took him into custody.

On Friday, January 19 at 1:05 p.m. Oakland Police officers responded to a report of a robbery in the 900 block of Webster Street. A description of the armed suspect was broadcast, and he was arrested by OPD and BART police officers at a nearby BART station. A firearm and large amount of money were recovered.

On Saturday, January 20 at 12:41 a.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a burglary in process in the 6200 block of Shattuck Avenue. Upon arrival, the officers located and arrested the burglary suspect. The loss was recovered.

On Saturday, January 20, at 2:16 a.m., Oakland Police officers conducted a traffic stop in the 1100 block of 18th Street. Upon contact, the officers saw a firearm in plain sight in the vehicle. The suspect was arrested.

On Monday, January 22, at 4:20 p.m., Oakland Police officers took a strong arm robbery suspect into custody during a car stop. The robber had taken multiple items from a retail establishment in the 7200 block of Bancroft Avenue. The loss was recovered.

On Tuesday, January 23, at 3:01 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a report of a battery victim in the 200 block of Rishell Drive. The victim was located and transported to a local hospital in critical condition. The suspect was taken into custody.

## *February 2018*

At 9:40 p.m. on Thursday, February 1, Oakland Police officers responded to an alarm call in the 8900 block of International Boulevard. Upon arrival, the officers noticed signs of a forced entry. Upon searching the building, they located and arrested one suspect.

On Sunday, February 4, at 5:30 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to the 2900 block of Broadway, where a robbery had just occurred. The officers located the suspect a few blocks away and made an arrest.

On Sunday, February 4, at 2:37 a.m., Oakland Police officers were dispatched to the 1700 block of Telegraph Avenue on a report that someone was brandishing a firearm. Officers canvassed the area and located the suspect nearby. He was arrested for carrying a loaded, concealed weapon.

On Sunday, February 4, at 2:30 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a call of a man assaulting a woman in the 9600 block of MacArthur Avenue. The victim was transported to a local hospital where she was listed in stable condition. Officers located and arrested the suspect.

On Sunday, February 4, at 12:41 a.m., Oakland Police officers responded to the intersection of 29th Street and Broadway. Citizens reported that a man was unconscious inside of a vehicle. A firearm was in plain view on the passenger seat next to him. Officers recovered the weapon and took the suspect into custody.

At 8:40 a.m. on Tuesday, February 6, Oakland Police officers responded to the 700 block of West Grand Avenue, where an attempted robbery had just occurred. The officers took the suspect into custody.

At 8:03 a.m. on Wednesday, February 28, Oakland Police officers responded to a suspicious vehicle in the 3400 block of Elm Street. The car's plate had been switched. The officers detained the driver, who was on probation, and arrested him when they located a firearm in the vehicle.

On Saturday, February 24 at 10:48 p.m., Oakland Police officers driving northbound in the 2800 block of 23rd Avenue heard a gunshot and observed a suspect pointing a firearm into the air. The suspect was detained and arrested. The firearm was also recovered.

## *March 2018*

On Thursday, March 29 at 3:07 p.m., an Oakland Police sergeant in the area of 6th Street and Brush Street saw an altercation between two men. One of the men assaulted the other with a knife and then fled the scene by bicycle. The sergeant directed officers to the suspect and they arrested him. The weapon was recovered.

On Wednesday, March 28 at 4:21 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a local hospital to speak to a gunshot victim who had been wounded in the 7600 block of MacArthur. Upon investigation, the officers learned that the victim had also been identified as a suspect in the shooting incident. The officers arrested him.

On Friday, March 23 at about 3:30 p.m., the Oakland Police Department responded to the 9000 block of International Boulevard regarding a robbery that had occurred earlier that morning. Upon arrival, the officers contacted the victim and she directed them to the suspect, who was still nearby. Officers arrested the suspect, an adult male Oakland resident.

On Tuesday, March 20 at 10:45 a.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a strong arm robbery in the 800 block of Douglas Avenue. Witnesses directed the officers to the suspect and he was arrested. The loss was recovered.

On Sunday, March 18 at 5:49 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to the 3400 block of 38th Avenue to investigate a report of an armed robbery. The officers obtained a description of the suspects and the suspect vehicle. Within a few hours, a patrol officer located the vehicle, and three of the suspects were taken into custody.

At 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, March 18, Oakland Police officers responded to an attempted carjacking in the 2800 block of E. 10th Street. When they arrived, the officers arrested the suspect, who was detained by a good Samaritan.

On Sunday, March 18 at 1:33 a.m., Oakland Police officers responded to an armed robbery and attempted carjacking on Skyline Boulevard near Joaquin Miller Road. During the robbery, the suspect was wounded by the victim. When the officers arrived, they found the suspect in critical condition. The officers provided first aid to the suspect until he could be transported to a local hospital.

On Saturday, March 17 at 3:40 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to the 6200 block of College Avenue where a strong arm robbery had just occurred. Several witnesses were able to direct the officers to the suspects. The officers arrested both suspects.

On Tuesday, March 13 at 1:45 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to the 7700 block of International Boulevard, where a suspect had shot at two bail enforcement agents during an attempt to flee. The suspect was arrested for assault with a firearm.

On Monday, March 12 at 9:35 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to an armed robbery in the 2900 block of Broadway. Upon arrival, the officers found the suspect safely detained by store security. A firearm was recovered and the suspect was arrested.

On Saturday, March 10 at 3:29 a.m., Oakland Police officers on patrol were alerted to a suspicious vehicle in the 5900 block of E. 16th Street. Two people were asleep in the car, one of whom was on parole. Upon conducting a search of the vehicle, the officers located a firearm and narcotics for sale. The parolee was arrested.

On Friday, March 9 at 9:26 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to an assault in a homeless encampment in the 2500 block of Embarcadero. Upon arrival, they located the victim, who was transported to a local hospital in stable condition. After a long standoff, the suspect was taken into custody.

On Friday, March 2 at 11:20 p.m., Oakland Police officers responded to a report of an assault with a deadly weapon in the 300 block of 13th Street. The suspect had been complaining about the quality of the food and after being escorted out, he returned with a pocket knife. Upon arrival, the officers took the suspect into custody.

On Thursday, March 1, Oakland Police officers were flagged down at the Eastmont Substation by a person whose vehicle had been burglarized. At 3:25 p.m., the officers located the suspects in the 400 block of West A Street in Hayward and conducted a traffic stop. A stolen firearm was recovered and the two suspects were arrested.
