# RE-CREATE

1st prize \$50 • 2nd prize \$30 • 3rd prize \$20

**Re-Create** is a recycled art competition and exhibition that is open to student artists (K -12) in Oakland schools. Students are invited to create artwork using discarded or reused materials, and compete for prizes.

## Eligibility

Students (K - 12) attending Oakland schools.  
Original work – not previously exhibited.  
One entry per artist, or collaborative group.  
Only 10 entries per classroom (if entering as individuals). Collaborative projects are encouraged.

## Rules of Entry

Art must be fabricated from 100% found, reused or recycled materials (excluding glue, paint, etc...).  
All art must be display-ready.  
Construction to be strong and secure.  
All 2-D art must be framed and wired for hanging.  
Art must have a completed Entry Form attached.  
Prizes will be awarded for  
1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each category:  
High School (9 - 12)  
Middle School (6 - 8)  
Upper Elementary (4 - 5)  
K / Early Primary (K - 3)

Student Collaboration (groups/classes of students)

Honorable Mentions will be awarded for outstanding work.

All artists will receive awards for excellence in art.

## Criteria for Judging

Artistic creativity and originality..... (50%)

Skillful use of 100% discarded or reused materials ..... (50%)

Entries must be delivered to: 1423 Broadway, Frank H. Ogwa Plaza entrance, Oakland.  
Saturday & Sunday, November 10th - 11th from Noon - 4pm.

## Notification

All entries will be exhibited. Awards will be announced at the Artists' Reception on Nov 16, 2012.
