Eligibility:

Single-Family Homes

- Residents call to schedule your appointment

2-4 Unit Buildings

- Tenants must contact landlord.
- Only property owners and managers may schedule appointments.

**Separate for recycling!
Proper sorting and set-out
can save you fees and fines.**

Here's How:

Single-Family Homes

- Call (510) 613-8710 to schedule a pickup appointment.
- A customer service representative will review with you your set-out items.
- Your appointment will be scheduled within 2 weeks of your call.
- Look for your Pickup Confirmation Notice in the mail and retain.
- Mark your calendar and prepare for pickup.

2-4 Unit Property Owners and Managers

- Only you may schedule a pickup for your tenants.
- You'll get extra Pickup Confirmation Notices in the mail to share with tenants.
- Ensure proper set-out! Property owners are liable for fees and fines.

When you call to schedule a pickup,
Please tell us if any of these items are included:

Quantity:

- Large Residential Appliances (Max 3)
- Computer Monitors and TVs (Max 2)
- Computer CPUs
- Mattresses (Max 3 sets)
- Tires (Max 4)
- Yard Trimmings (No. Of bundles or bags)
- Clean Wood (Under 4' long and 6" in diameter, must be tied together in a bundle)
- Scrap Metal (Approx. bulk and weight)

If someone offers to haul your junk for a low price, chances are that it is being illegally dumped. If your stuff is found illegally dumped, you can be held liable for removal costs, penalties and fees, even if you did not dump it yourself.

SEPARATE FOR RECYCLING!

SET OUT FOR SAFETY!

- **Call (510) 613-8710 to schedule your pickup appointment.**
- Place items at the curbside by 6 am and no earlier than 1 day before your scheduled pickup date.
- Early or late set-outs will be subject to a minimum City fine of \$810.

3 CUBIC YARD LIMIT FOR NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS

Up to three cubic yards – equals a 3x3x9 ft. area or about twenty 32-gallon bags.

Property owner will be charged for excess materials over the three cubic yard limit, at \$25 per cubic yard.

RECYCLABLE ITEMS – Group A & B: Items must be sorted for recycling and safely set-out, not piled or stacked.

Group A (weight limit does not apply)

- **Large Residential Appliances** (Maximum 3)
 - Prepare for Pickup:
 - Have doors and lids removed
 - Keep dry and free of garbage
 - Place upright (not on their sides)
 - No leaking or hazardous materials
 - **Do not stack large items on top of each other**



- **Computer Monitors, TVs** (Maximum 2)



- **Computer CPUs**



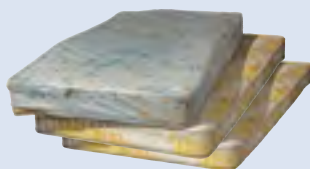
- **Tires** (Maximum 4)
Automobile tires or smaller



- **Small Appliances**



- **Mattresses** (Maximum 3 sets)



Group B (weight and size limit apply)

- **Yard Trimmings**
No herbicide contamination



- **Clean Wood**
Unpainted, untreated wood only must be tied and bundled, and do not exceed 4 ft.



- **Scrap Metal**
Painted items OK, no electronics or glass parts

- **Cardboard**
Flattened & bundled



Prepare for Pickup:

- All yard trimmings must be bundled and tied or put in paper gardening bags (available in many hardware stores). Yard trimmings in plastic bags cannot be recycled and will count toward your 3 cubic yard limit
- Branches, wood or scrap metal must not exceed 4 ft. long or 6 in. in diameter
- Branches and wood must be tied together in a bundle
- Put smaller items in cardboard box or paper bag



NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

Group C (3 cubic yard limit)

- **Household Furniture and Carpet**
Carpet must be bundled, less than 4 ft. long



- **Other:**
Any non-hazardous items that meet the weight and size limit are OK



Painted wood/doors must be less than 6 ft. long



Loose items must be bagged or boxed

Items not properly prepared and separated will count towards your 3 cubic yard limit.

STOP, DO NOT INCLUDE

No item over 75 pounds
(except for Group A and furniture)

Unacceptable items will be rejected, left at curb, reported to City of Oakland, and will be subject to minimum \$810 fine.

No Hazardous Waste

No paint, pesticides, solvents, car batteries or materials containing asbestos. For hazardous waste disposal information, contact the Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Program (800)606-6606 or www.household-hazwaste.org.

No Rocks, Dirt or Concrete
