
## 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Bike to Work Day Pancake Breakfast at City Hall

**Oakland, CA** – Oakland will host one of the biggest Bike to Work Day events in the Bay Area on Thursday, May 12, 2016. Hundreds of bicyclists will join Mayor Libby Schaaf and other elected officials for a ride to Frank Ogawa Plaza, where they will join in a pancake breakfast to celebrate the 23<sup>rd</sup> annual **Bike to Work Day**.

- Press conference at 8:15 a.m. featuring the Mayor and City Council members
