RESOLUTION REQUESTING ADOPTION OF A SOURCE REDUCTION AND RECYCLING PROCUREMENT POLICY FOR THE CITY OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 (AB 939) requires jurisdictions to divert 25% and 50% of their landfill disposed waste by the years 1995 and 2000, respectively; and

WHEREAS, AB 939 requires jurisdictions to develop and adopt Integrated Waste Management Plans which detail how the waste diversion mandates will be met; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland recognizes the need to increase the demand for recyclable materials; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the Source Reduction and Recycling Procurement Policy (Policy) is to increase the recycled content of products purchased by the City and to reduce waste in the manufacture and use of products and packaging purchased by the City; and

WHEREAS, a further goal of the Policy is to complement and enhance purchasing goals related to minority, women and local business enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the Source Reduction and Recycling Procurement Policy will complement and support the City's economic development and business attraction and retention goals by encouraging the development of jobs by recyclable product manufacturers in the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is committed to being a regional leader with respect to sustainable growth and recycling market development; and

WHEREAS, buying recycled products is the first step toward encouraging the location of recycling products manufacturers in the community and providing employment opportunities for the citizens of Oakland; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council adopts the Source Reduction and Recycling Procurement Policy attached hereto, and a copy has been approved by the City Attorney and is on file with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to initiate all necessary rules, regulations and instructions to establish and implement the Source Reduction and Recycling Procurement Policy.


