

## 7<sup>TH</sup> STREET WEST OAKLAND TRANSIT VILLAGE Improvement Project - Phase I

**Project Work Description:** The project work consists of replacement and widening of existing sidewalks, construction of concrete bulbouts and curbs and gutters, construction of landscaped raised median, planting trees, bushes and ornamental grass, installation of irrigation system, construction of steel gateway structure, bus shelter, Blues Walk of Fame plaques and dancing light sculptures, installation of new street and pedestrian lights, installation of colored crosswalk, installation of bike lanes, grinding, paving, pavement marking, striping, traffic signal modifications and other related work. The project was designed by City of Oakland Public Works Engineering & Design Division and outside consultants.

**Project Location:** 7<sup>th</sup> Street from Union Street to Peralta Street

**Construction Cost:** \$4,000,000

**Funded by:** MTC, ARRA, ACTIA, BART and Former Oakland Redevelopment Agency

**Revised Construction Schedule:** May 2010 – June 2015 (Due to schedule conflict with BART Seismic Retrofit Project and fabrication of Blues Walk of Fame plaques, the schedule was delayed.)
