

MAYOR'S COMMISSION ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (MCPD)

The MCPD was established in 1980 to represent and address the issues faced by people with disabilities. This group of appointed volunteers is committed to promoting the participation of people with disabilities in all aspects of City government and the broader community. Since 1990, the MCPD has acted as the City's designated advisory body for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act by advising the Mayor and City Council, reviewing City policies, programs and activities, and rendering advice on disability issues to other City boards, City staff, and private agencies. The Commission also sponsors special events celebrating the achievements of young people with disabilities, disability art and culture, and National Disability Awareness Month.

The Commission meets on the second Monday of each month from 1:00 to 3:30 P.M. All meetings are located in City Hall Hearing Room 3, adjacent to the 14th Street entrance.
